NOMINATION FORM FOR FRESH FACES OF ENGINEERING AWARD 2012**

The UEC is proud to sponsor the annual **Fresh Faces of Engineering Award 2012**, an award that spotlights the outstanding contributions of America's youngest professional engineers. The UEC New Faces of Engineering Award strives to promote the accomplishments of young engineers by highlighting their engineering contributions and the resulting impact on society. The campaign is designed to enhance and improve the image of engineering by: (1) putting faces to what has often been referred to as "the stealth profession", (2) showing a group of young, diverse and talented engineers, thereby portraying engineering as an exciting profession open to everyone, (3) providing both stimulation and incentive for college engineering students to explore the variety of career options available to them with their engineering degrees as well as encouraging high school students to study engineering in college, and (4) help engineering students understand they are part of a global profession. The Utah Engineers Council will accept nominations and make a selection to be recognized at the Engineers Week Banquet in February 2012.

INSTRUCTIONS: Nominations are limited to one per member society. Nominees must hold an engineering degree, have received an Engineering Bachelors degree no earlier than February 1, 2007, and have been involved in projects that significantly impact public welfare or further professional development and growth. The projects may be completed as part of a team at the engineer's place of employment or through any other professional or civic affiliation. An Initial Nomination Package, including full name of the Nominee, contact information and color head-shot photo, must be received by November 18, 2011. A Full Nomination Package with the suggested information below must be submitted to the Awards Committee Chair, Dr. Joseph Martone, at the contact information shown at the bottom of this form by December 16, 2011. Note that the relative weighting factor for each category is indicated by the percentage shown in parentheses.

Feel free to include résumés, letters of recommendation (3 maximum) from peers and associates, and other information about the candidate's professional and civic activities. Each nomination must be accompanied by a nominating letter from the sponsoring professional society.
